Musical Notes

Playlist: It wouldn't be March without some beautiful Celtic tunes. This month we have a lively polka and a beautiful waltz.

The Ballydesmond Polka: This polka is generally the second in a set of three traditional fiddle tunes known as the Ballydesmond Polkas. It is also commonly referred to as the Gneeveguilla Polka. Ballydesmond refers to a town called Desmond. Here is a favorite version Ballydesmond.

Sheebeg Sheemore (melody and harmony): Referencing two hills or two ranges of hills depending on the source, Si Bheag Si Mhor (the medieval Irish title) translates to Little Fairy Hill, Big Fairy Hill. This tune is attributed to the blind harpist Turlough O'Carolan who originally wrote it as an Irish air but the song has since been popularized as a waltz. Here's a beautiful rendition Sheebeg Sheemore.

Repertoire Song of the Month: Of course, in keeping with our Celtic theme, our repertoire song for March is **Saint Anne's Reel**.

Helpful Hints

Google Drive Assist

In order to access the Preston Pluckers folder on Google Drive from your computer or tablet:

- 1. Create a Google account.
- 2. Login to the Google account.
- 3. You can get to Google Drive by either searching for Google Drive or by going to the Google homepage and clicking on the dotted grid (Google apps) next to your profile pic/pic location on the upper right hand corner of the screen and selecting Google Drive.
- 4. In Google Drive, use the menu on the left to select **Shared with me.** You will see a list of files or folders that have been shared with you. If you do not see the Preston Pluckers folder, let me know.
- 5. To download music files in bulk, right click on the Month (2022 September) and you should see an option to download the whole folder. A second method is to highlight the folder by left clicking on it and then click on the three vertical dots to the right of the trashcan (top right of the screen) which will also provide you with a download option.
